PLEASE READ ALL THE WAY THROUGH

1. Please wear clothing and shoes that are appropriate for ALL weather
2. Please bring plastic bag/s to clean up after your dog. Every owner is 100% responsible to clean up after their dog
3. Please do not feed your puppy or dog their dinner before class. If they are full they will be a bit sleepy
4. It is best to bring four (4) different types of rewards with you to each class. Fill four (4) baggies FULL of soft yummy rewards that have smell (you will not use all of them but you need to be prepared and not run out). They should be HIGH VALUE rewards. Keep in mind you need to bring what your dog considers HIGH value, not what you consider to be high value.
5. Bring you or dog/puppy on a 6 foot lead (no flexi leads) and on a flat buckle collar or harness. No choke, pinch, or e-collars are allowed, ever.
6. Your dog/puppy needs to have a bit of exercise before coming to class, whether it is some play training or taking a nice leash walk. Please take the time to potty your dog before class.
7. **NOTE:** If your dog/puppy is showing signs of not feeling well or is sick, please call your veterinarian for an appointment and let us know you will not be coming to class. Puppies with diarrhea cannot attend class.
8. **NOTE:** There are no refunds for classes that you miss. It is your responsibility to show up to each class. If you cannot make class, e-mail or call and I will let you know what we covered.
9. If you would like one on one time for additional training or to spiff up the behaviors you are currently working on, I do offer private sessions. Call or e-mail to schedule a time.
